Welcome

Steve welcomed the guests and explained that the Monday evening was the only evening that we could get the room with no venue fee as the lower bar is closed Monday evening and thanked Colin Thwaites Accord coordinator for organizing the meeting.

Nate Brown Take Kare Foundation.

Nate Brown detailed the back ground and initiatives introduced by Take Kare with the ultimate goal to get young people home safely from the city. The safe spaces initiatives are now available at Town Hall and Kings Cross are being well used and some of the individuals that have received assistance for are returning and signing up as ambassadors and assisting with getting young people home safely.

Action: CVA Accord to work with Take Kare to establish how we can work together.

Senior Constable Grant Campbell MAC

Grant detailed MAC concerns for the season and highlighted that dance parties on the Harbour are very high risk and would receive intense scrutiny from the Authorities. Grant explained that some operators have voluntarily agreed to dance party exclusions on their license, which was sensible and responsible. There will be the seasonal compliance boarding by multiple Authorities in November and December, interruptions will try to be minimized. Grant explained that it is the current MAC policy to object to initial license applications however he can be contacted to discuss new licenses.

Erin Obrien OLGR

Erin explained that the OLGR and ILGA no longer sit under the Department of Trade and Investment and now rest under the new Justice Department due to cabinet desires. Secondary supplies to minors is a big compliance

focus at present and should be carefully watched on vessels as most can have minors aboard. Documented in-house training and best practice RSA will assist should there be a breach.
